

Nitery Reading Series Application

Nitery Experimental Theater (NExT) aims to present bold and relevant performance meant to challenge, transform, and cultivate meaningful artistic expression. NExT is also committed to diverse communities, aesthetics, and politics that exist within the Stanford community. By building connections between student-artists and the Department of Theater and Performance Studies, NExT intends to foster performance as an integral forum for community conversation. Performance at NExT may be raw, political, provocative, or even playful. NExT is not a new home for performance; NExT uses performance to make Stanford a new kind of home.

The Series

For the 2016-17 academic year, NExT is in development. We will be conducting outreach for artists throughout the Stanford community in order to enact our mission. In addition to the seven TAPS productions already scheduled in the Nitery for 2016-17, NExT will prioritize low-tech, simple staged-readings. We are therefore soliciting applications for events which require minimal technical support. Think workshops, scenes from plays in development, or staged readings of full length plays. We hope that such informal events will create an artist-first atmosphere for new artists to build the inaugural season of NExT. For those of you who have ambitions beyond such small-scale events: we can't wait to meet you, and hope you apply for our 2017-2018 season.

Who can apply?

All Stanford University graduate and undergraduate students are encouraged to apply.

How do I apply?

Fill out the application attached, and then simply email it in. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis. Please be sure to attach the following:

- A short (<300 word) description of your proposed event and how it connects to the NExT mission statement
- If you are part of an organization (a student theatre club for example) a shorter (<200 word) description of your organization and how it connects to the NExT mission statement.
- A copy of your script or score. (Electronic or PDF formats are preferred.)
